An Education Session will occur on Wednesday, March 25 that is comprised of three panel discussions. The session will focus on educational models that cut across traditional disciplinary boundaries, involve innovative delivery methods, are integrated over multiple grade-levels, or reach out to constituencies that are often under-represented in discourse of Bay watershed issues. Aspects will include identifying innovative educational programs now in place as well as linking environmental education programs at schools or centers and Chesapeake Bay research being conducted by various scientific organizations.
